BEFORE THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE KEET, AJ**

DIRECTIVES (27, 28, and 29 March 2023)

1. All matters will be heard in court 6D.
2. Introductions may take place at 9.45.
3. Matters will be called according to seniority.
4. Please inform Peter Dithipe if matters will not be proceeding for whatever reason, as soon as possible. His number is 076 114 2763. Also please make a widely shared note of such intended removal on Caselines.
5. Matters that are settled, should have a separate bundle which must include: offer and acceptance, draft order, confirmation letter and contingency fee agreement (if applicable).

6. Practitioners are requested to file succinct heads of argument no later than 12PM on the day before the hearing of the matter. Paragraph 6 of this directive is not applicable to matters which are enrolled for Tuesday, 26 September 2023.
7. Legal practitioners are requested to create a separate section on Caselines containing the separate documents, which are relevant to the default judgment, which documents should include, but not be limited:
 - 7.1 practice note;
 - 7.2 heads of argument;
 - 7.3 compliance affidavit;
 - 7.4 SIC (TIC) order;
 - 7.5 proof of service of the SIC (TIC) order;
 - 7.6 application for default judgment;
 - 7.7 proof of service of the application for default judgment;
 - 7.8 notice of set down of application for default judgment, with proof of service;
 - 7.9 pleadings;
 - 7.10 merits documents (if outstanding, alternatively merits court order);
 - 7.11 expert reports;
 - 7.12 past medical expenses schedule (if applicable);
 - 7.13 contingency fee agreement (if applicable);
 - 7.14 draft order.
8. Practitioners are requested to provide two hard copies of the draft order at the hearing of the matter.
