DIRECTIVE FOR DEFAULT JUDGEMENTS TRIAL COURT PROCEEDINGS BEFORE THE HONOURABLE ACTING JUSTICE LAUBSCHER AJ TO BE HEARD ON 1 TO 5 JULY 2024

- Matters will be heard in **open court** starting at **09h30**. The court number will be widely circulated when available.
- 2. Introductions will be made in open court when a matter is called.
- 3. Removals and postponements will be called first. Thereafter, matters will be heard in order of seniority of the practitioner arguing the matter.
- 4. Draft orders must be uploaded to CaseLines in WORD, as set out in paragraph7 below. It is unnecessary to bring hard copies to court.
- 5. Heads of argument, and all other documents, must be uploaded to CaseLines no later than 17h00 on the day preceding the date of hearing, including as set out in paragraph 7 below.
- 6. If a matter becomes settled or is not proceeding for any reason, immediately

and during or after hours, an email must be sent to <u>Amashala-Shiburi@judiciary.org.za</u> AND to <u>antonlau@law.co.za</u>, indicating the reason.

- 7. A separate section 001 at the top of the CaseLines named "HEADS OF ARGUMENT AND RELEVANT DOCUMENTS" must be created, including the following documents:
 - 7.1 Strike out order.
 - 7.2 Suggested draft order in Word.
 - 7.3 Heads of argument.
 - 7.4 Latest actuarial report (report only without notices).
 - 7.5 Merits concession / settlement (offer and acceptance).
 - 7.6 Confirmation of seriousness of injuries on RAF letterhead.
 - 7.7 Order appointing *curator ad litem*.
 - 7.8 Report by *curator ad litem*.
 - 7.9 Contingency fee agreement.
 - 7.10 Consent to appointment as Trustee / curator bonis.

IF A MATTER IS SETTLED THE FOLLOWING MUST ALSO BE INCLUDED

- 7.11 Offer and acceptance.
- 7.12 Draft order.
- 7.13 Confirmation letter from RAF in respect draft order.
