**DIRECTIVE IN RESPECT OF FULL BENCH APPEALS, LAW SOCIETY MATTERS
AND ADMISSIONS – TERM 4: 2021, WEEK 2**

1. All matters will be dealt with in open court, unless unforeseen circumstances render a matter to be heard virtually. Individual arrangements will be made with parties in such circumstances.
2. Parties will be informed as to the court venue closer to the date of hearing.

Re: Appeals

3. The parties are directed to respond by no later than Friday 8 October 2021 before 13h00 in respect of the following:
 - 3.1. Confirming that the appeal will proceed on the date it is enrolled for hearing;
 - 3.2. Confirming the expected duration of argument to be presented;
 - 3.3. Confirming which parts of the record will be focused on;
4. If the parties intend to supplement their written heads of argument with further written submissions, these are to be filed no later than Monday 11 October 2021 at 10h00.

5. The applicant must ensure that all notices and the notice of set down are uploaded to CaseLines.
