**TRIALS INTERLOCUTORY COURT HEARING DIRECTIVES FOR 18 TO 22
OCTOBER 2021 BEFORE GRANOVA (AJ)**

1. The matters will be heard sequentially and the hearing will take place via Teams and the daily link will be provided. The participants email addresses to be invited to the hearing can be forwarded to Ms Mabona at TNgcobo@judiciary.org.za and thobilengcobo77@gmail.com.
2. Matters will be called in seniority.
3. Practitioners are requested to upload proposed draft orders in Word format providing for compelling orders (if not already granted), provision for leave to apply for striking of defences upon failure to adhere to the compelling order on a date allocated by the Registrar, or, if an allocated trial date is still within this term, then at that trial date, a direction that the Plaintiff may retain such a trial date, and costs.
4. Practitioners are requested to ensure that the service requirements have been complied with and proof thereof uploaded, in particular

where striking out orders are sought after failure to comply with compelling orders.

5. If there have been responses to either the applications or compelling orders, these are to be included or referred to in the practice notes or supplementary practice notes.
