Allocated Opposed Motions Roll before Acting Judge Groenewald

11 TO 15 MARCH 2024

Directives:

- Acting Judge Groenewald will be in the opposed motion court during the week of 11 to 15
 March 2024. Legal representatives are requested to verify the court venue on the day roll.

 The allocated roll for matters before Acting Judge Groenewald is attached hereto.
- 2. Any removals, postponements and settlements can be called by counsel in open court on **Monday, 11 March 2024 at 9:30**. The judge's secretary should immediately be informed if a matter is to be removed, postponed, or has become settled or if for any other reason the papers need not be read.
- 3. Parties must ensure that all papers are to be fully uploaded to CaseLines.
- 4. All Legal Practitioners must deliver <u>hard copies</u> of the relevant documents to the reception at Brooklyn Advocates Chambers, 220 Dey Street, Pretoria by no later than 15:00 on Monday, 4 March 2024. The hard copies should be printed from CaseLines and must contain the Caselines pagination.
- 5. All matters will be heard in **open court**. Court will start at **9:30**. Introductions will be conducted at **9:15** or 15 minutes prior to appearance.

- 6. Attention is drawn to the provisions of the Consolidated Practice Directive 1 of 2024 which became effective on 26 February 2024.
- 7. The parties are directed to ensure, in accordance with the prevailing practice directive, that a **joint practice note** (where such a joint practice note has not already been uploaded) is uploaded onto CaseLines no later than Monday 4 March 2024 containing the following:
 - 7.1 Names of the parties and the case number
 - 7.2 Names and telephone numbers of all counsel in the motion.
 - 7.3 Nature and brief summary of the motion.
 - 7.4 Relief sought at the hearing by the party on whose behalf counsel is appearing.
 - 7.5 An updated estimate of the probable duration of the application.
 - 7.6 Number of pages in the application and whether all the papers need to be read and if not, which portion need not be read.
 - 7.7 Common cause facts relevant to the relief sought.
 - 7.8 Issues requiring determination.
 - 7.9 Relevant portions of the papers to be read.
 - 7.10 Any other matters relevant for the efficient conduct of the hearing.
- 8. In the case where an opponent fails to cooperate in the preparation of a joint practice note, the aggrieved party may file a unilateral practice note and declare the opponent in default. The parties' attention is drawn to the provisions of paragraph 25.19 of Consolidated Practice Directive 1 of 2024.
- 9. Should a matter for any reason not proceed on the given date, you are directed to expeditiously inform the office of Acting Judge Groenewald via email to **Mr Ashley**Ndzukula andzukula@judiciary.org.za and to upload the notice of removal to Caselines.

 A party shall not unilaterally remove a matter from the roll.
- 10. Non-availability of counsel representing any of the parties will not be a reason for the matter not to proceed on the allocated date of the hearing.
- 11. Where no practice notes or heads have been filed on behalf of any party, the other party

should upload a supplementary practice note to Caselines directing attention to where: the notice of set down of the application may be found; and how service of both (1) the notice of set down and (2) the practice note, and heads of argument were effected.

- 12. Save where matters are indicated to be allocated for purposes of a roll call, all parties must attend to court on the dates and times indicated below. Parties should be mindful that the allocated date or time may change. Counsel should structure their arguments taking consideration of the estimated duration allocated to the matter.
- 13. Parties should ensure that the proposed draft orders are uploaded onto Caselines <u>and</u> emailed in Word format to **Mr Ashley Ndzukula <u>andzukula@judiciary.org.za</u>** at least the **three days** before a particular matter will be heard. Parties must bring **two hard copies** of the draft order to Court. Once an order is made, the parties will receive a copy of the order via CaseLines.
- 14. Draft orders should indicate the hearing date of the matter, the Judge's name, and the manner in which the matter will be heard (i.e. open court), and at the end of the draft order the names and details of all counsel/practitioners and of their instructing attorneys must be included.
- 15. Queries regarding any opposed motion set down for hearing from 11-15 March 2024 must be addressed to the secretary of the presiding judge to whom the matter has been allocated for hearing. No direct communications should be directed to the judge.
- 16. Kindly mention the roll number and the case number in the subject line of your emails.
