DIRECTIVES FOR THE UNOPPOSED MOTION COURT ON 12 MAY 2022 BEFORE DAVIS J

The unopposed motion courts before Judge Davis for **Thursday 11 May 2022** will be run as follows:

- Judge Davis hear the unopposed motion roll in open court but that only practitioners in the following matters on the roll need to appear: Numbers 76, 82, 85, 89, 94, 96, 99, 100, 101 and 102. The remainder of the matters will be dealt with in terms of the documents uploaded on Caselines, but practitioners in those matters are entitled, but not obliged to appear.
- 2. In all matters the proposed draft order must be emailed in Word format (and <u>settlement agreement</u>, if any in PDF) to Judge Davis' secretary, Ms Mabona (<u>TMabona@judiciary.org.za & Tumetsi.judiciary@gmail.com</u>) and be uploaded on caselines by no later than 15h00 a day before the hearing date.
- 3. All matters which are in order will be disposed of on paper unless practitioners wish to make oral submissions. If this is the case, that

must be clearly stated in the practice note or in a supplementary practice note which must be delivered together with the proposed draft order. Practitioners must in any event be available on the respective dates to make submissions should clarification of any issue be required, for which purpose Judge Davis will also upload Caselines notes.

4. The Consolidated Directives dated 11 May 2020 must be complied with.
