

- Please be advised that there will be a roll call for all urgent matters before Kumalo J. The roll call will be conducted on Tuesday, 28 March 2023 in open court, Palace Court B at 10h00 (Palace of Justice).
- 2. All applications must be properly issued by the Registrar seated at the General Office in the High Court Building, with the exception of applications brought outside of the ordinary court hours, before the secretary to Judge Kumalo (as the senior judge) is approached for the enrolment of applications.
- 3. The contact number for urgent applications to be heard out of ordinary court hours is 068 104 7107. The number is not to be used for general enquiries or for any issue other than urgent applications to be heard out of ordinary court hours. The phone will only be answered after normal court hours.
- 4. Applications before Judge Kumalo will be heard in <u>open court, Palace Court B</u> at 10h00 by way of physical hearings during normal court hours.
- 5. Applications heard out of the ordinary court hours will be heard via Microsoft Teams at a time indicated by the Judge.

- 6. Due to the time constraints imposed by the nature of urgent court, no consideration will be given to documents belatedly filed, save in exceptional circumstances. A satisfactory explanation must be incorporated in the practice note.
- 7. Parties must ensure that all papers necessary for the urgent hearing are uploaded by no later than Sunday, 26 March 2023 at 12h00.
- 8. In all applications a Practice Note must be filed setting out the following:
 - a. The grounds of urgency;
 - b. Nature of relief sought;
 - c. Total number of pages;
 - d. An indication which portion of the papers must be read;
 - e. The estimate duration of the matter; and
 - f. Contact details for the legal practitioners, which much include both cellphone numbers and email addresses.
- 9. A matter will be struck from the roll where parties have failed to file a Practice Note, unless there is good cause or exceptional circumstances Parties must prepare hard copy draft orders to be handed up when matters are called.
- 10. Save with the leave of the Judge, no documents (save for heads of argument) may be uploaded after 12h00 on Sunday 26 March 2023.
- 11. In all opposed applications, heads of argument of Applicant parties in each matter must be uploaded by no later than 14h00 on Sunday 26 March 2023 and Respondents to file no later than Monday, 27 March 2023 at 10h00.
- 12. Practitioners are reminded of the normal Rules and practice pertaining to the bringing of urgent court applications and are urged to take note of the Memorandum to Practitioners *in re*:
