DIRECTIVE:

- 1. There will be roll call on Tuesday 15 February 2024 in court 4B at 10h00am.
- 2. Matters which were not properly enrolled and/or ready at the close of the roll (including matters that are not on caselines) by Thursday 15 February 2024 at 12h00pm, will be struck from the roll with exception of any applications brought outside of ordinary court hours on an extremely urgent basis.
- 3. The contact number for urgent applications to be heard out of ordinary court hours is <u>068 104</u> <u>7107.</u> This number is NOT to be used for general queries or for any issues other than <u>urgent applications to be heard out of ordinary court hours.</u> The phone will only be <u>answered after normal court hours.</u>
- 4. In all applications a Practice Note must be filed by Friday 16 February 2024 at 12h00pm, setting out the following:
 - 4.1 grounds of urgency;
 - 4.2 Nature of relief sought;
 - 4.3 Total number of pages;
 - 4.4 An indication of which portion of the papers must be read;
 - 4.5 The estimate duration of the matter; and
 - 4.6 The contact details of the legal practitioners, which must include both mobile number and email addresses.
- 5. Matters will be struck for want of a Practice Note, certificate of urgency and directive compliance affidavit unless there is good cause shown or exceptional circumstances prevail.

- 6. Due to time constraints imposed due to the nature of urgent court proceedings, no consideration will be given to documents belatedly filed, save in exceptional circumstances. A satisfactory explanation must be incorporated in the Practice Note.
- 7. Save with the leave of the Judge, no further documents, with the exception of the Heads of Argument, may be uploaded after Friday 16 February 10h00pm.
- 8. In all opposed applications, the Heads of Arguments of the Applicant must be uploaded by no later than 16h00pm on Friday 16 February 2024 and the Respondents to file same no later than Monday 19 February 2024 at 10h00am.
- 9. Caselines will be frozen to prohibit any further filing on Monday 19 February 2024 at 10h00am.
- 10. Please inform the Judge's Secretary of any settlements or removals immediately.

- 12. Application brought out of the ordinary court hours will be heard via MS Teams at a time indicated by the Judge.
