### DIRECTIVE

1. All matters set down for 16 July 2024 will be called on Tuesday (16 July 2024) at 10h00 unless allocated to a different slot below, or a different arrangement is made prior to roll call at the instance of the Judge.
2. Please note that two secretaries will assist Strydom AJ during the week. Parties are directed to address all communications to the secretary assisting on the day.
3. All matters already will be heard physically during office hours, unless prior timeous arrangements are made with the relevant Judge's secretary. Matters not yet on the roll will be heard as directed by the Judge. All matters brought after hours will be heard virtually.
4. Practice notes and heads of argument, in addition to being loaded to CaseLines, must be e-mailed in Word version to the relevant secretary per the details set out above.
5. In matters already on the roll (below), practice notes, and updated practice notes where appropriate, as well as heads of argument should be loaded as soon as possible, but in any event not later than 13h00 on Monday, 15 July 2024.
6. Heads of argument should be submitted in all matters. In unopposed and *ex parte* matters brief heads on the main issues will suffice.
7. Counsel are required to comply with all relevant Practice Directives.
8. **Should a matter not be proceeding or become settled the relevant secretary is to be advised without delay and a widely shared note is to be made on Caselines.**

9. In all matters heard physically in Court, one copy of the proposed draft order of each party should be available to be handed up in Court. However, parties are to ensure that they are able to effect amendments to their proposed orders at the instance Judge.
10. The Judge may communicate with the parties' representatives via widely shared notes posted on the electronic file. Legal Representatives are to look out for these communications and are requested to respond to such communications. Please also note the comments on the roll below
11. In addition to Court Online, Legal Practitioners are to ensure that all documents in all matters are also available on the Caselines platform and to confirm with the secretary hear the matter whether access was granted to such file. Matters without a CaseLines file are listed below. Those matters will be called at roll call on Tuesday. Practitioners should endeavour to resolve this problem forthwith.
