TRIAL DEFAULTS JUDGEMENT ROLL COMMENCING ON 31 MARCH 2025 TO 04 APRIL 2025

BEFORE THE HONOURABLE JUDGE KOLLAPEN AJ

DIRECTIVES:

1. All matters will be heard in open court, commencing at 10:00.
2. Introductions will take place in open court.
3. Matters that have become settled, removed or postponed by agreement must be communicated by email to Ms X Vilakazi at XVilakazi@judiciary.org.za without delay.
4. The roll will be dealt with as follows:
 - a. Removals
 - b. Settlements
 - c. Roll called by seniority of Advocates and/or Attorney appearing in the matter

5. Legal practitioners need only hand in one copy of the draft order, the draft order must contain date of hearing, court room and the Acting Judge's surname.
6. Legal practitioners must before handing up the draft order that ensure that the draft order contains the correct case number, correct name of the parties and if there's any amendment made by manual script, such amendment is initialled.
7. The following should be included in every draft order:

This Order is made an Order of Court by the Judge whose name is reflected herein, duly stamped by the Registrar of the Court and is submitted electronically to the Parties/their legal representatives by email. This Order is further uploaded to the electronic file of this matter on Case Lines by the Judge or his/her Secretary. The date of this Order is deemed to be _____.

8. Detail of the Road Accident Fund must also be included in the draft order, i.e. claim's handler and claim / link number (if available).
9. All court documents to be uploaded by no later than 12h00, two days prior to the hearing date. Failure to comply may cause the matter to be removed from the roll;
10. All papers in all matters must be uploaded on CaseLines. If a matter is not uploaded on CaseLines it will be removed or struck off from the roll.

11. If a late notice of intention to defend is (or was) filed by the Defendant, the Defendant must provide the court with a chronology and a written reason for the belated notice of intention to defend. In addition, Counsel for the Defendant must make submission as to the effect of the notice of intention to defend on the Plaintiff's application for Default Judgment in light of the recent case law regarding this issue, (unless the matter will be removed by agreement between the parties)

12. Practitioners are requested to upload succinct Heads of Argument, Practice Note and the proposed Draft Order onto Caselines not later than 12 pm TWO days before the hearing of the matter.
