JUDICIAL CASE MANAGEMENT MEETINGS : NEUKIRCHER J for the week of 16 - 20 November 2020

The following directive is issued in respect of the JCMM's for the week of 16/11–20/11/2020:

1. The completed Form 10 is to be uploaded to CaseLines by no later than 24 hours prior to the date of set down.
2. All practitioners are to ensure that the Form 10 has been comprehensively completed and, where necessary, supplemented with the following (where applicable) separately:
 - 2.1 if merits are in dispute the reasons must be provided;
 - 2.2 if any of the expert reports are still outstanding: which are outstanding and when will they be filed? (indicated on the Form 10)
 - 2.3 if joint minutes are outstanding: which are outstanding and when will they be filed? (indicated on the Form 10)
 - 2.4 how many days are needed for trial? (indicated on the Form 10)
 - 2.5 if a date for trial has been furnished, please indicate this on the Form 10.
3. No hearings are required on the date the JCMM is enrolled.
4. In the event that the Form 10 is not timeously uploaded to CaseLines as indicated in 1 supra, the matter will be removed from the roll. In the event that there are any expert reports outstanding (other than an Actuarial calculation), the matter will be removed and may be re-enrolled when the report is filed.
5. Parties will either receive the signed Form 10 via email or will be notified that certification is refused.
