**Directive for Judicial Case Management meetings before Pienaar (AJ) for 29, 30, 31 March 2021 and 1st of April 2021**

1. Parties are referred to paragraph 21 of the Judge President's directive 1 of 2021, as well as paragraph 16 and 32 thereof:
  - 1.1 The effective date of the directive is 18 February 2021.
  - 1.2 Where there is no trial date already allocated and no engagement by parties (such as the RAF), Plaintiffs are instructed to follow the procedures as set out in paragraph 21 and should not have applied for JCM dates.

- 1.3 No readiness certificates will be granted where such applications for a JCM date was made after 18 February 2021 (Subject to the right of the representatives to address the Court as per 1.5 below).
- 1.4 Parties are instructed to avail themselves of the procedures as set out in the directive.
- 1.5 Unless the legal representatives wish to address the Court, such matters may be removed from the JCM roll by emailing the notice of removal to AThangavhuelelo@judiciary.org.za as well as athangavhuelelo@gmail.com.
- 1.6 Kindly inform Ms Thangavhuelelo of removals by email as soon as possible. The notice of removal must be uploaded by the legal representatives to CaseLines.
- 1.7 If removed, parties need not attend the virtual meeting.
- 1.8 Where parties, applied for JCM's prior to the effective date of the Directive, parties may address the Court on why they are of the view that the Court has a discretion to grant a trial readiness certificate.
2. All matters will be heard virtually at 09:30 each day and parties are to ensure that their correct details are conveyed to AThangavhuelelo@judiciary.org.za.
3. Parties are to ensure that the Form 10s are uploaded onto the Caselines system at least one day before the convening of the meeting. Parties are also requested to send the Form 10 in Word format to AThangavhuelelo@judiciary.org.za as well as athangavhuelelo@gmail.com.

4. All parties are requested to upload proof of service on the Defendant on notice of enrolment of the Judicial Case Management meeting. Failure to upload the required proof on CaseLines will result in removing the matter from the roll.
