**DIRECTIVES FOR JUDICIAL CASE MANAGEMENT -, SETTLEMENT- AND
DEFAULT JUDGMENT COURT BEFORE JUDGE V TLHAPI**

**MATTERS ON MONDAY 01 AUGUST 2022, TUESDAY 02 AUGUST 2022, THURSDAY 04
AUGUST 2022 AND FRIDAY 05 AUGUST 2022 WILL BE HEARD IN OPEN COURT (8B)
FROM 9h00. MATTER ON WEDNESDAY 03 AUGUST 2022 WILL BE HEARD VIRTUALLY
FROM 10h00am(the link will be circulated on 02 August 2022).**

1. **SETTLEMENTS** – Some settlements will be considered on paper as noted on CaseLines and respect of others counsel maybe requested to appear.
2. For those matter heard in open court one draft order must be handed up when applications are moved and a copy must be uploaded onto CaseLines in word format.
 1. Where matters are settled the written confirmation of the settlement and attachment must be noted in the draft order attached to the draft order;
3. **JCMC** – In all applications a Form 10 must be completed and uploaded onto CaseLines. Counsel should have regard of the judge's note on CaseLines for trial readiness or non-readiness. In matters where the judge has certified the matter trial ready, form 10 certificates will be issued.
4. In **DEFAULT JUDGMENT** applications failure to address fully issues upon which the order is sought may result in the application being struck of the roll.

5. A practice note, stating the nature of the application and the date on which the application is on the roll, should be filed on Caselines by the latest one full court day before the day the matter is enrolled. Counsel must have regard to the Judge President's most recent directive.
6. In all applications where heads of argument must be filed, a failure to do so will result in the application being struck off the roll.
7. Regarding the formation of trusts, issues of concern by the judge will be raised at the hearing.
8. Counsel is requested to have regard to the 'Widely Shared Note' function on CaseLines.
