**NOTICE REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE JUDGE PRESIDENT'S
DIRECTIVES FOR JUDICIAL CASE MANAGEMENT -, SETTLEMENT- AND
DEFAULT JUDGMENT COURT BEFORE JUDGE E VAN DER SCHYFF**

1. All matters will be heard in **open** court unless there is a written email request for a virtual hearing. Matter heard on a virtual platform will be heard after the proceedings in open court are finalised.
2. Settlements and Default Judgment applications will be heard from **9h00**.
3. One draft order must be handed up when applications are moved.
 1. Where matters are settled the written confirmation of the settlement must be attached to the draft order;
 2. Where applicable, the draft trust deed and confirmation of the proposed trustee(s) must be attached to the draft order;
 3. The powers of trustees must provide that funds may only be invested with registered financial institutions – if the trust deed provides otherwise counsel must motivate. Security must be provided as required by the Master of the High Court.
4. A practice note, stating the nature of the application and the date on which the application is on the roll, should be filed on Caselines by the latest one full court day prior that the date that the matter is enrolled. Counsel must have regard to the Judge President's most recent directive.
5. Failure to file a practice note **in compliance with this notice, dealing with each of the paragraphs above separately**, may result in the application being struck off the roll.
6. In all applications where heads of argument must be filed, a failure to do so **will** result in the application being struck of the roll.
7. Counsel is requested to have regard to the 'Widely Shared Note' function on CaseLines as queries may be raised using this function.
