FINAL DIRECTIVE FOR THE WEEK COMMENCING 19 AUGUST 2024

FAMILY COURT MATTERS BEFORE THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE LINGENFELDER

1. All family court matters before Madam Justice Lingenfelder (AJ), for the week of 19 to 23 August 2024 will be heard in open court at 10h00 unless otherwise directed. Details of the court allocated should be checked on the Day Roll.
2. Matters before Madam Justice Lingenfelder (AJ) will be heard on the following dates:
 - Monday, 19 August 2024: Matters no. 1 to 19, **66**
 - Tuesday, 20 August 2024: Matters no. **20**, 36, 37 and 40 to 45
 - Wednesday, 21 August 2024: Matters no. 46 to 52 and 61 to 65, **60B**
 - Thursday, 22 August 2024: **Matters no. 60A, 60C and 60D**
3. Matters number 21 to 35, 38, 39, 53 to 60, 60E to 60H and 67 to 71 will be heard by Madam Justice Amien (AJ). Please contact Madam Justice Amien's secretary, Ms Simone Bhana (sbhana@judiciary.org.za / 012 314-9049) in respect of these matters.
4. All parties **must** be suitably dressed for Court.

5. In respect of divorces:

5.1 Plaintiffs in unopposed divorce matters need not appear in person **where an evidence affidavit has been uploaded to Caselines;**

5.2 If an evidence affidavit is not uploaded, alternatively if the Family Advocate has not endorsed a settlement agreement and/ or raised a query, the Plaintiff must appear in court.

6. Parties must ensure that a case profile is created for their matter on Caselines and that all relevant documents are uploaded before 13h00 on Thursday, 15 August 2024. **No further papers filed after the 13h00 deadline will be considered.**

7. If a draft order is to be made an order of court, one hard copy must be brought to be handed up in court. Draft orders and settlement agreements, where applicable, must **CORRECTLY** indicate the Judge's particulars, date, court, and names and contact details of both Counsel and their instructing attorney.

8. If the parties decide for any reason that the matter shall not proceed, same must immediately be communicated to the Judge's Secretary.

9. Introductions shall take place at 09h30 in Office 5.8, Fifth floor, High Court Building.
