- 2.** The Court will sit at 10:00.
- 3.** Introductions will be made in Chambers at 09:45.
- 4.** Matters will be heard in open court.
- 5.** The Family Court Directives must be complied with.
- 6.** The court will not deal with matters that were not enrolled timeously. Contact the enrolment office if your matter was properly enrolled but does not appear on this Roll.
- 7.** No documents may be uploaded on Caselines after 12:00 noon on Friday, 16 May 2025. Matters without the record being uploaded to Caselines by noon will be struck from the Roll.

8. Both parties must be present in opposed matters involving minor children. The Court may require viva voce evidence.
9. Counsel must have a hard copy of the proposed draft order, with another draft uploaded to Caselines.
10. Draft orders must comply with the Directive, including identifying the Presiding Judge, the date of the sitting, and the court room. The draft order must also record the following:

"This Order is made an Order of Court by the Judge whose name is reflected herein, duly stamped by the Registrar of the Court and is submitted electronically to the Parties/their legal representatives by email. This Order is further uploaded to the electronic file of this matter on Case Lines by the Judge or the Judge's Secretary. The date of this Order is deemed to be [to insert the date of the sitting, using the format date/month/year]."
11. Allow at least 7 days for signed court orders to be uploaded (orders that are to be signed urgently must be mentioned to the Judge).
