DIRECTIVE: URGENT COURT ROLL BEFORE MADAM JUSTICE

BOTSI-THULARE

8-11 JULY 2025.

1. Kindly note that the matters detailed in the attached Urgent Court roll have been allocated to Acting Judge Botsi-Thulare.
2. The Practice Directive regarding Urgent Applications (Chapter 13.24) still applies (to opposed and unopposed applications) and the Rules pertaining to urgency will be strictly enforced. Compliance with annexure "A" (13.24), more particularly par [4], subparagraphs (1) to (11) thereof, as referred to in paragraph 11 of Chapter 13.24 of the Practice Manual,

will also be strictly enforced. If a matter is not ready to be adjudicated on the date and the time indicated in the notice of motion (subject to the degrees of urgency) and/or not so urgent as indicated in the Rules and the Practice Directive, it may be struck off the roll in which event a punitive costs order may be made.

3. All matters will be heard in open court at 10:00. The court in which the matters will be heard will be reflected on the day roll which is circulated daily. Only in the event of unforeseen circumstances will matters be dealt with on electronic platforms and in such an event a link for virtual sitting will be circulated. Practitioners will be informed in writing as soon as reasonably possible in the event that hearings are to be conducted virtually.
4. For matters that are to be removed, postponed, or have become settled, the parties must email MRaseroka@judiciary.org.za.
5. For matters that will be heard from 8 to 11 July 2025, practitioners are requested to upload the Heads of Argument, Practice Note, and proposed Draft Order (in both PDF and MS Word Formats) onto Caselines in a separate created section by **12:00 on Saturday, 5 July 2025**.
6. Service of process in all urgent applications must comply with the Rules of Court. Deviations will only be condoned if good cause is shown. Where an agreement was reached by the respective parties' legal representatives to provide for the electronic exchange of papers, this must be specifically stated in the practice note.

7. All draft orders handed up must contain the Judge's name, date, contact details, and roll number.
8. All legal practitioners should be in court by 10:00, failure to do so will result in your matter(s) being removed with no order to costs.
9. Introductions may be attended to in chambers (2:12) at 09:45.
