DIRECTIVE: APPLICATIONS FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT AND SPECIAL INTERLOCUTORY ROLLS BEFORE THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE KEHRHAHN AJ

29 SEPTEMBER 2025 to 03 OCTOBER 2025

1. All matters to be heard in open court. The court in which the matters will be heard will be reflected on the day roll which is circulated daily.
2. Court and the hearing will commence at 10h00.
3. Introductions are to take place at 09:45 in chambers 3.2.
4. Removals and postponements will be called first.
5. Matters on the SIC roll will thereafter be called (according to seniority).
6. Matters on the default judgment roll will be called after the SIC roll (according to seniority).
7. Draft orders to be uploaded onto CaseLines. One hard copy of the draft court order will also be required.
8. Complete details of the parties' representatives (including Counsel), Acting Judge's name, date of hearing, mode of hearing, the number on the roll, correct case number and court number must be included in the draft order.
9. Details of the Road Accident Fund must also be included in the draft order, i.e. claim's handler and claim / link number (if available).

10. Notices of removals, postponements, settlements must be brought to the attention of our office forthwith by a Widely Shared Note on CaseLines and emailed to Ms Mpuru at TsMpuru@judiciary.org.za.

11. The following disclaimer should be included in every draft order:
