GENERAL DIRECTIVES (Friday, 21 November 2025, 11h15)

1. The matters allocated to Moultrie AJ in urgent court for week 8 of Term 4 are set out below.
2. Save in respect of matters in which a date and time has already been allocated below or in which representatives may yet be advised otherwise by means of a widely-shared note by Moultrie AJ or his secretary on CaseLines or by email, a **roll call will be held in open court at 10h00 on Tuesday, 25 November 2025** at which the remaining matters on Moultrie AJ's roll will be called and either (i) heard; or (ii) allocated to a later time in the week for hearing. The court number will be identified in the daily roll published by the office of the Deputy Judge President.
3. Applicants in all matters are directed to ensure **by no later than 17h00 on Friday, 21 November 2025** that the CaseLines hearing bundle contains all relevant documents filed of record in the matter as at that time, and to ensure that all parties' (or their representatives) have been "invited" to the Caselines hearing bundle. Applicants in matters where the hearing bundle contains no indication of opposition from any one or more cited respondents as at the above time are in particular required to ensure that the bundle contains adequate proof of service of the founding papers on all such respondents.
4. Any document sought to be delivered by any party after 17h00 on 21 November 2025 must be both (i) uploaded onto the CaseLines hearing bundle; and (ii) emailed to the Judge's secretary at the email address above. In addition (save in exceptional instances, which must



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be explained in the email), all such documents (save for the practice note referred to below) must have been duly filed via the CourtOnline registry before being uploaded to the CaseLines hearing bundle and emailed, and the document so uploaded and emailed must be the version that was filed on CourtOnline (i.e. including the CourtOnline cover sheet showing time of filing and watermarks).

5. Counsel or attorneys appearing for every party should **email a practice note to the judge's secretary no later than 13h00 on Monday, 23 November 2025** setting out (i) their cellphone and email contact details and those of their instructing attorneys; (ii) an indication of the procedural status of the matter as at the time of the delivery of the practice note; (iii) an estimation of the likely duration of the hearing; (iv) whether the representatives of all cited parties agree to an online hearing on either Thursday, 27 November 2025 or Friday 28 November 2025 (in which event Moultrie AJ will consider allocating same, subject to the state of the rest of the roll); and (v) brief submissions on service, urgency and the merits, with reference to the relevant page numbers in the Caselines hearing bundle, as well as relevant authority, where necessary. Parties should similarly submit a complete draft order in Word format, and bring a hardcopy thereof to the hearing.
6. Representatives must ensure that the uploading of any document to the CaseLines hearing bundle after 17h00 on 21 November 2025 as contemplated in 4. and 5. above does not affect the pagination of any other document in the bundle as at that time. Failure to do so may result in adverse costs orders.
7. Save as set out above, paragraphs 24.10 (dealing with return dates for rules *nisi*), 12.25 and 28 of Practice Directive 1 of 2024 (revised 12 June 2024) as well as the Practice Manual will be applied. Further or amended directions may be published via "widely shared notes" posted on the CaseLines file, and parties are required to look out for these communications and respond to such widely shared notes, as requested.
8. Any party unable to comply with any of the directions set out above, or becoming aware of any fact that may affect the smooth operation of the court must contact the judge's secretary, copying the legal representatives of the other parties (if any), as soon as they become aware of such inability or fact
