1. All insolvency court matters allocated before Madam Justice Retief will be heard in open court on the date and time indicated as per the allocated roll. Legal practitioners are advised to confirm the relevant court on the day roll.
2. The court roll will be divided into unopposed and opposed matters. Please peruse the allocated roll attached.
3. All **Unopposed insolvency** matters will be dealt with on **Monday, 07 September 2026**.
4. All **Opposed insolvency** matters will be dealt with on the date as per the allocated roll commencing the **08 September 2026**.
5. **Strict adherence to the Insolvency Court directive will apply to assist the Judge to effectively prepare and to minimize abuse of process.**

6. The Judge must be alerted as soon as an interlocutory application has been filed after matters have been enrolled and or which will interfere with the hearing of the main application duly set down. In such instance, the Judge will try and assist to give direction to ensure the main application is heard as soon as reasonably possible in the next 7-week cycle.
7. Matters that become settled, removed or postponed by agreement must be communicated by e-mail to Ms. without delay.
8. Draft Orders on CaseLines must indicate the words "Draft Order", however, Counsel are advised to hand over one copy to court with words "Court Order".
9. Matters not reflected on caselines when this roll is published will be removed as preparation is hampered.
10. A practice note must be filed if the matter is unopposed and comprehensive joint practice note together with heads of argument in opposed matters. Such to be uploaded by no later than **3 September 2026 by 12h00**.
11. No papers may be filed and duly uploaded onto caselines by any party **after 3 September 2026, 12h00** without the Judge's leave.
12. Legal practitioners must before uploading the Draft Orders on Caselines, ensure that the draft order contains the correct case number, correct names of the parties involved, that the application appeared before **THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE Retief J** and that the matter was heard at a specific court and include the following Disclaimer:

This Order is made an Order of Court by the Judge whose name is reflected herein, duly

stamped by the Registrar of the Court and is submitted electronically to the Parties/their legal representatives by email. This Order is further uploaded to the electronic file of this matter on CaseLines by the Judge or her secretary. The date of this Order is deemed to be the set down date.

13. Counsel and attorneys appearing in the Dedicated Insolvency Court will be expected to have read the relevant practice directives of the Insolvency Court.
