**URGENT COURT DIRECTIVE AND COURT ROLL BEFORE THE HONOURABLE MADAM
JUSTICE VUMA
FOR 15 SEPTEMBER – 18 SEPTEMBER 2026**

10 SEPTEMBER 2026

1. Court proceedings will be in **OPEN COURT**.
2. Introductions will take place in **OPEN COURT**.
3. Madam Justice Vuma J will hold a roll call on all matters before her on **Tuesday, 15 September 2026 at 10h00** in open court (as allocated on the day roll).
4. Court proceedings will commence at 10h00.
5. All practitioners are required to appear in Court on **Tuesday, the 15 September 2026**.
6. All in-person litigants should come to Office number 2.12 at the main High Court building for assistance.
7. All applications must be properly issued by the Registrar seated at the General Office in the High Court Building, with the exception of applications brought outside of the ordinary court hours, before the secretary to Madam Justice Vuma J (**as the Senior Judge**) is approached for the enrolment of applications.
8. Kindly refer to the Day Roll for the allocated Court.

9. Matters that were not ready at the close of the roll, that is **12h00 Thursday, the 10th of September 2026**, and files where the Judge's secretary has not been invited onto Caselines, including those where the relevant affidavits have not been filed/uploaded; or where the matters have not been indexed and paginated; will not be allocated and will resultantly be struck off unless a good cause or exceptional circumstances are shown in an affidavit explaining same. Any difficulties encountered must be communicated to the Judge's secretary timeously.
10. In all applications a Practice Note must be filed onto Caselines setting out the following:
- a. The grounds for urgency;
 - b. The nature of the application or the relief sought;
 - c. Total number of pages;
 - d. The estimated duration of the matter;
 - e. An indication as to which portions of the papers must be read;
 - f. If there is non-compliance with the Judge President's directives issued for the urgent court, the reasons for such deviation must be stipulated;
 - g. Parties should ensure that a Compliance Declaration is uploaded onto Caselines; and
 - h. Contact details of the legal practitioners, which must include both their cell phone numbers and email addresses.
11. Where no Practice Note has been filed by **Friday, the 11th of September 2026 at 16h00** the matter will be struck from the roll.

12. Master Bundles must be properly indexed and paginated. Each document must be individually identified, including Annexures. If not, the application will be struck from the roll.
13. Save with the leave of the Judge, no documents (save for the Heads of argument) may be uploaded after **16h00 on Friday, 11 September 2026**.
14. Matters that are to be removed, postponed, or which have become settled – Draft Orders should be uploaded in both PDF and WORD format and are to be emailed to **Ms. Lungelwa Nyilika at LNyilika@judiciary.org.za** no later than **Monday, 14 September 2026 at 16h00**.
15. Draft orders should contain a Disclaimer, indicating the date of hearing, Judges' names (i.e. Vuma J), manner of hearing (Open Court/Virtual) and the name and details of Counsel/Practitioner and those of the instructing attorney. See below disclaimer to be inserted.

DISCLAIMER: *"This Order is made an Order of Court by the Judge whose name is reflected hereon, duly stamped by the Registrar of the Court and is submitted electronically to the parties or their legal representatives by e-mail. This Order is further uploaded to the electronic file of this matter on Caselines by the Judge or his/her Judges Secretary. The date of this Order is deemed to be ____."*

16. In all opposed matters, Heads of Argument are to be filed by both parties by no later than **Saturday, 12 September 2026 at 16h00**. Strict adherence will be enforced on the grounds of urgency, failing which the matter will be struck from the roll.
17. There will be no piece-meal filing of affidavits that will be permitted.
18. If there is non-compliance with this Practice Directive, the matter will be struck from the roll, unless good cause is shown for non-compliance.
19. Please be aware that allocation does not mean that the matter is considered sufficiently urgent to be heard on the merits. Submissions will still need to be

made regarding the grounds of urgency at the hearing.

20. The contact number for urgent applications to be heard out of ordinary court hours is **068 104 7107**. The number is not to be used for general enquiries or for any issue other than urgent applications to be heard out of ordinary court hours. **THE PHONE WILL ONLY BE ANSWERED AFTER NORMAL COURT HOURS.**

25. Applications heard out of the ordinary court hours will be heard via **Microsoft Teams** at a time indicated by the Judge
26. Parties must have 1 copy of the draft order available to be handed up in court.
27. Service of process in all urgent applications shall comply with the Rules of Court. Where an agreement was reached by all the representatives of all parties to vary the requirements of the Rules to facilitate a wholly electronic exchange of papers, this must be specifically stated in the Practice Note.
