DIRECTIVES:

1. The opposed motion court before Mathopo AJ will be heard physically in open court, at the times and on the dates reflected in the roll below. A matter marked to be heard virtually will be heard on the platform notified by the secretary.
2. This roll constitutes notification, in terms of paragraph 25.15 of the Revised Consolidated Practice Directive 1 of 2024 as amended, of the day and time allocated to each matter.
3. Each practitioner must confirm in writing to the secretary, by no later than **Thursday, 13 August 2026**, that the matter proceeds, that the time allocated remains sufficient, and that the papers are complete.
4. The CaseLines file in each matter will be frozen at 13h00 on Friday, 14 August 2026. No party may thereafter upload any document to CaseLines, or deliver any document to the court, save with leave granted on written request to the secretary at the address given above.

5. Where the position has changed since the joint practice note was filed, an updated joint practice note must be uploaded to CaseLines and transmitted to the secretary before the file is frozen.
6. A practice note must state the nature of the application, the date on which the matter is on the roll, and the names and contact details of counsel and attorneys. It must be accompanied by the notice of final enrolment together with proof of timeous service.
7. All papers, heads of argument, practice notes, chronologies and lists of authorities must be accessible on CaseLines, and duplicate electronic court files must be archived. Any difficulty with access, including a file that will not load or will not open, must be raised with the Court Online helpdesk without delay and reported to the secretary. It is not to be raised for the first time at the hearing.
8. Practitioners are reminded of paragraph 25.1A of the Directive, which requires a party to take steps to address the non-compliance of an adversary. Non-compliance with paragraph 25 remains a ground for removal or striking from the roll, with punitive costs.
9. Draft orders must be uploaded in Word and PDF format and handed up in hard copy at the hearing. Each draft order must reflect the name of the presiding Judge, the date, the number of the matter on the roll and the mode of hearing, and must conclude with "BY THE COURT".
10. Legal representatives should be available ahead of the time allocated to them, in the event that a preceding matter concludes early or does not proceed.
11. Any removal, postponement or settlement must be notified to the secretary by email forthwith and recorded on CaseLines, and a notice of removal must be served and uploaded.
12. A request to alter an allocated day or time must be addressed in writing to the secretary before the hearing.
