NB! IF THE MATTER IS NOT COMPLIANT WITH THE ABOVE, THE MATTER WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY REMOVED FROM THE ROLL, WITH COSTS IN THE CAUSE.

NB! NO RETENTION OF PREVIOUSLY ALLOCATED DATES.

4. One hard copy of the draft order is to be handed up on the day of hearing.
Parties are to ensure that the case details, courtroom, and Judge's details are correct on the draft order.
5. Legal Practitioners are to have complied with the Practice Directives.
6. Removals will be called first. Thereafter the matter will be called in numerical order.
7. All removals must be brought to the attention of the Acting Judge's secretary by email to RinMavhungu@judiciary.org.za.
8. All court documents to be uploaded by no later than 16:00, two days prior to the hearing date. Ensure that the Practice note is timeously uploaded.
9. All draft orders in word, should be uploaded on Caselines. Kindly ensure that it complies with the practice directive, i.e the Judge's name, number on the roll, date complete details of the parties' representative (including Counsel), mode of hearing etc. Including the below disclaimer:
"This Order is made an Order of Court by the Judge whose name is reflected herein, duly stamped by the Registrar of the Court and is submitted electronically to the Parties/their legal representatives by email. This Order is further uploaded to the electronic file of this matter on Case Lines by the Judge or his/her Secretary. The date of this Order is deemed to be [date/month/year]."
10. Draft order must correctly reflect the number on the roll and correct case numbers;
11. The court will not deal with matters that were not placed timeously, if your matter was properly enrolled but does not appear on this roll, please contact the enrolment office; and
12. Please allow 7 court days for signed orders to be uploaded.
