URGENT COURT DIRECTIVES FOR 17 March 2026

- 1. ROLL CALL WILL BE HELD IN OPEN COURT AT 10H00 ON TUESDAY, 17 March 2026** at which all of the matters on Allen AJ's roll will be called and either heard or allocated to a later time in the week for hearing.
- If any matter settles or will not be proceeded with, the registrar of Allen AJ must be informed thereof immediately upon it becoming clear that the matter has been settled or will not be proceeded with. Failure to do so may attract punitive costs orders.
- All notices, affidavits, returns of service and other documents such as practice notes and heads of argument relevant to the application(s) are to be uploaded and accessible on CaseLines when the roll closes.
- Any document filed by any party after the roll closed must be both uploaded onto CaseLines and emailed to the Judge's registrar at the email address above. In addition, all such documents must (save in exceptional cases where this is impossible) be duly filed on CourtOnline before being uploaded.
- Matters where no practice note and no heads of argument have been filed in accordance with the Practice Directives will not be entertained.**
- Applicants should upload a complete draft order in Word format and bring a hard copy thereof to court.
- Representatives must ensure that the uploading of any document onto CaseLines after the roll closed does not affect the pagination of any other document in the bundle as at that time.
- Parties are to comply with Directive 1 of 2024 (revised 12 June 2024). Further or amended directions may be published via "widely shared notes" posted onto CaseLines and parties are required to look out for these communications and respond to such widely shared notes as requested.
- Any party unable to comply with any of the directives set out above or becoming aware of any fact that may affect the smooth operation of the court must contact the Judge's registrar, and copying the legal representatives of the other parties, as soon as they become aware of such inability or fact.

- 10.** All new applications must first be enrolled with the Urgent Court Registrar or the Judge's clerk as the case may be, who will thereafter bring the matter to the attention of the presiding Judge.
